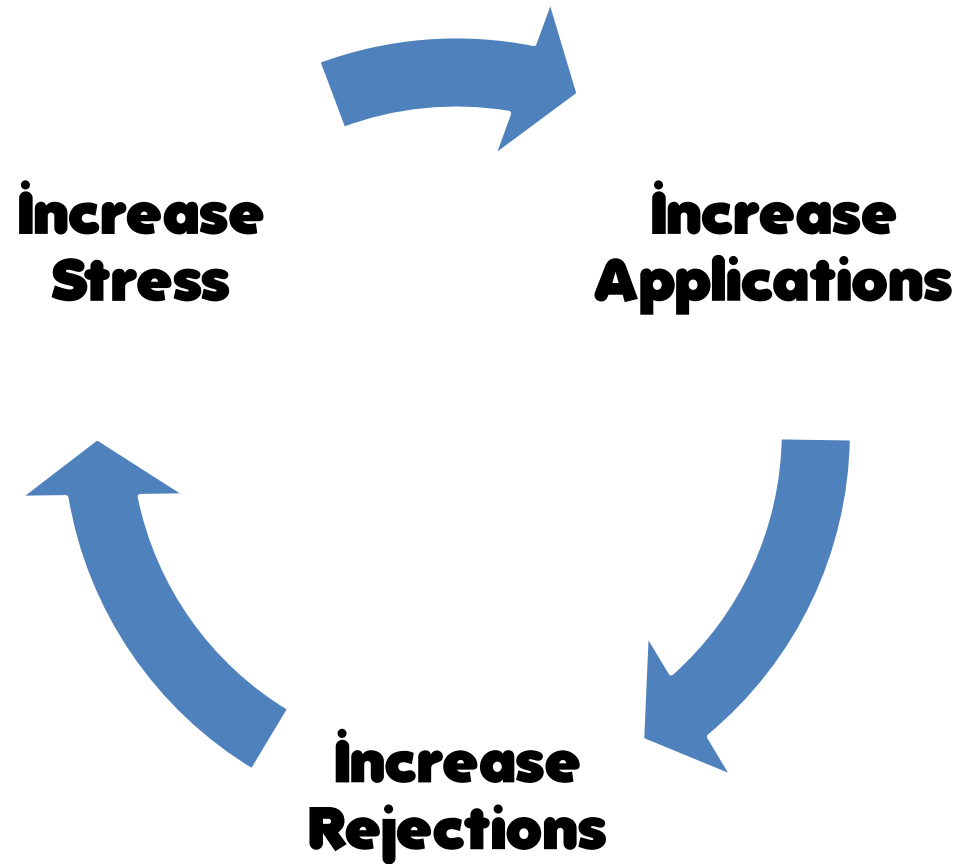


What's Happening in the Sector?
